

FUN FACTS ABOUT ST. TERESA OF AVILA

- Teresa of Avila is how we know her. However, her given name was Teresa Ali Fatima Corella Sanchez de Capeda y Ahumada.
- She was born on March 28, 1515, in Avila, Spain, and died at the age of 67 on Oct. 4, 1582.
- She was named a saint of the Catholic Church on March 12, 1622.
- In 1970, Saint Teresa of Avila was declared a Doctor of the Church for her writing and teaching on prayer.
- Teresa became a Carmelite nun who found life in the cloister quite lax and set about efforts to renew the spiritual and monastic life.
- The Interior Castle was written by Teresa of Avila in 1577 as a guide for spiritual development through service and prayer.

Holy Matrimony: Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months prior to a wedding date. Contact the rectory for an appointment with a priest or deacon. Weddings can be scheduled in English, Spanish and Creole.



Anointing of the Sick: This sacrament is available for any baptized Catholic who is seriously ill or suffering from the effects of advanced age. It is also recommended for anyone who is going to undergo serious surgery. Please call the rectory to schedule an appointment for a priest to visit your home. A communal celebration of this sacrament will be scheduled twice a year.
