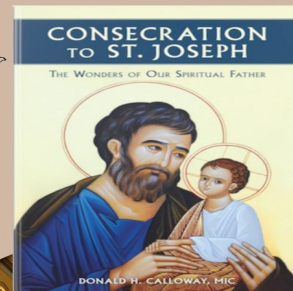

at the **Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph**.

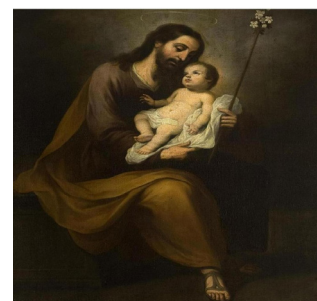
The Mass will be on the **first Friday** of the **Month** at **8am**.

SEVEN SUNDAYS OF ST JOSEPH (FOURTH)

Fourth sorrow: Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is set for ... a sign that is spoken against ... that thoughts out of many hearts may be revealed" (Lk 2:34-35).

Fourth joy: For my eyes have seen thy salvation which thou hast prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles (Lk 2:30-32).



WE KNOW THAT GOD speaks to us, that He is close to us and calls us unceasingly to unite ourselves to his Love with our whole being, in very specific situations. God speaks to us every day, at every moment, through the events and people around us. In everything that happens to us we can discover part of the divine plan that we each are called to carry out. At least twice a day, according to Jewish practice, Jesus prayed the Shema Israel, a prayer that begins: "Hear, O Israel: the Lord is our God" (Deut 6:4). Then as now, the first step is to be attentive to God's voice calling us. "Saint Joseph, more than anyone else before or since, learned from Jesus to be alert to recognize God's wonders, to have his mind and heart awake." [3]

Baptism: Baptisms are available in English, Spanish and Creole. Parents may schedule their child's baptism by contacting the parish office.

Holy Matrimony: Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months prior to a wedding date. Contact the rectory for an appointment with a priest or deacon. Weddings can be scheduled in English, Spanish and Creole.



Anointing of the Sick: This sacrament is available for any baptized Catholic who is seriously ill or suffering from the effects of advanced age. It is also recommended for anyone who is going to undergo serious surgery. Please call the rectory to schedule an appointment for a priest to visit your home. A communal celebration of this sacrament will be scheduled twice a year.
