THE PROMISE OF NEWNESS - PROMESA DE NOVEDAD



The Magi, who following a star are led to the Christ child in Bethlehem, personify all those who believe and those who long for God. That longing keeps hope alive in the community of believers, which from week to week continues to plead: "Come, Lord Jesus. Believers who feel this longing are led by faith to seek God, as the Magi did, in the most distant corners of history, for they know that there the Lord awaits them. They go to the peripheries, to the frontiers, to places not yet evangelized, to encounter their Lord. What the Magi found in Bethlehem was a promise of newness. And as they fell to their knees before the small, poor and vulnerable Infant, the unexpected and unknown Child of Bethlehem, they discovered the glory of God." *Pope Francis*
