SPIRITUAL COMBAT, VIGILANCE AND DISCERNMENT COMBATE, VIGILANCIA Y DISCERNIMIENTO

The Christian life is a constant battle. We need strength and courage to withstand the temptations of the devil and to proclaim the Gospel. This battle is sweet, for it allows us to rejoice each time the Lord triumphs in our lives.

COMBAT AND VIGILANCE

We are not dealing merely with a battle against the world and a worldly mentality that would deceive us and leave us dull and mediocre, lacking in enthusiasm and joy. Nor can this battle be reduced to the struggle against our human weaknesses and proclivities (be they laziness, lust, envy, jealousy or any others). It is also a constant struggle against the devil, the prince of evil. Jesus himself celebrates our victories. He rejoiced when his disciples made progress in preaching the Gospel and overcoming the opposition of the evil one: "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven" (Lk 10:18).

DISCERNMENT

How can we know if something comes from the Holy Spirit or if it stems from the spirit of the world or the spirit of the devil? The only way is through discernment, which calls for something more than intelligence or common sense. It is a gift which we must implore. If we ask with confidence that the Holy Spirit grant us this gift, and then seek to develop it through prayer, reflection, reading and good counsel, then surely we will grow in this spiritual endowment GAUDETET ET EXSULTATE, Pope Francis.

La vida cristiana es un combate permanente. Se requieren fuerza y valentía para resistir las tentaciones del diablo y anunciar el Evangelio. Esta lucha es muy bella, porque nos permite celebrar cada vez que el Señor vence en nuestra vida.

EL COMBATE Y LA VIGILANCIA

No se trata solo de un combate contra el mundo y la mentalidad mundana, que nos engaña, nos atonta y nos vuelve mediocres sin compromiso y sin gozo. Tampoco se reduce a una lucha contra la propia fragilidad y las propias inclinaciones (cada uno tiene la suya: la pereza, la lujuria, la envidia, los celos, y demás). Es también una lucha constante contra el diablo, que es el príncipe del mal. Jesús mismo festeja nuestras victorias. Se alegraba cuando sus discípulos lograban avanzar en el anuncio del Evangelio, superando la oposición del Maligno, y celebraba: «Estaba viendo a Satanás caer del cielo como un rayo» (Lc 10,18).

EL DISCERNIMIENTO

¿Cómo saber si algo viene del Espíritu Santo o si su origen está en el espíritu del mundo o en el espíritu del diablo? La única forma es el discernimiento, que no supone solamente una buena capacidad de razonar o un sentido común, es también un don que hay que pedir. Si lo pedimos con confianza al Espíritu Santo, y al mismo tiempo nos esforzamos por desarrollarlo con la oración, la reflexión, la lectura y el buen consejo, seguramente podremos crecer en esta capacidad espiritual. GAUDETET ET EXSULTATE, Papa Francisco.

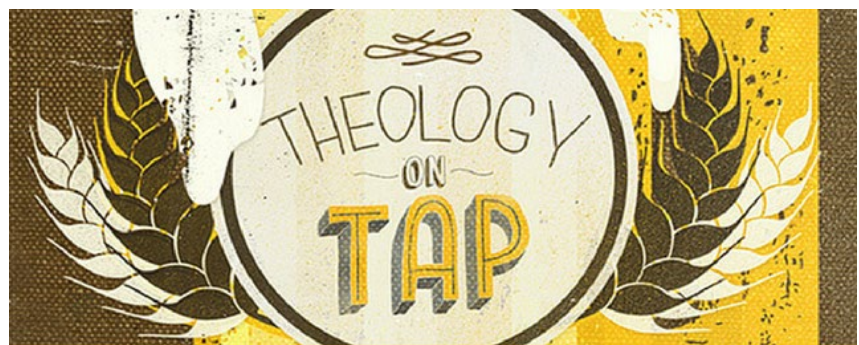


Arise Season Five "We are the Good News"

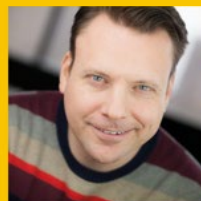
