ST. TERESA'S FEAST DAY

Saint Teresa was born in Avila, Spain, on March 28, 1515. She died in Alba, on October 4, 1582. Teresa's personality was extroverted, her manner affectionately buoyant, and she had the ability to adapt herself easily to all kinds of persons and circumstances.

The gift of God to Teresa in and through which she became holy and left her mark on the Church and the world is threefold: She was a woman; she was a contemplative; she was an active reformer. St. Teresa's great work of reform began with herself. She made a vow always to follow the more perfect course, and resolved to keep the rule as perfectly as she could. Teresa received permission from Rome to establish numerous reformed convents even though her efforts at reform were oftentimes misunderstood, misjudged and opposed. Yet she struggled on, courageous and faithful. And in the midst of all this she clung to God in life and in prayer. Toward the end of her life she exclaimed: "Oh, my Lord! How true it is that whoever works for you is paid in troubles! And what a precious price to those who love you if we understand its value." Teresa's writings, especially

the Way of Perfection and The Interior Castle, have helped generations of believers. Her writings on prayer and contemplation are drawn from her experience: powerful, practical and graceful.

Pope Gregory XV canonized her in 1622 and in 1970, the Church gave her the title of doctor of the Church. As St. Josephs and St. Teresa of Avila parishioners, we can take pride in citing Teresa's many accomplishments, while also taking pains to follow her example,

and taking comfort in the knowledge that Teresa, like us, faced her share of doubts and challenges along the way. St. Teresa of Avila Church, CA © 2018

Santa Teresa nació en Ávila, España, el 28 de marzo de 1515. Murió en Alba, el 4 de octubre de 1582. La personalidad de Teresa era extrovertida, su actitud afectuosamente flotante, y tenía la capacidad de adaptarse fácilmente a todo tipo de personas y circunstancias.

El don de Dios a Teresa por el cual ella se hizo santa y dejó su huella en la Iglesia y en el mundo es triple: ella fue una mujer; fue contemplativa; ella fue reformadora activa. La gran obra de reforma de Santa Teresa comenzó con ella misma. Hizo un voto siempre de seguir el camino más perfecto, y resolvió mantener la regla tan perfectamente como pudo. Teresa recibió permiso de Roma para establecer conventos reformados, incluso cuando sus esfuerzos de reforma fueron a menudo mal entendidos, mal juz-

gados y obstaculizados. Sin embargo, ella siguió luchando, valiente y fiel. Y en medio de todo esto, se aferró a Dios en la vida y en la oración. Hacia el final de su vida, ella exclamó: "¡Oh, mi Señor! ¡Qué cierto es que quien trabaja para ti está pagado en problemas! Y qué precioso precio para aquellos que te aman si entendemos su valor". Los escritos de Teresa, especialmente el Camino de la Perfección y el Castillo del Interior, han ayudado a generaciones de creyentes. Sus escritos sobre la oración y la contemplación se extraen de su experiencia: poderosos, prácticos y elegantes.

El Papa Gregorio XV la canonizó en 1622 y, en 1970, la Iglesia le dio el título de doctor de la Iglesia. Como feligreses de San José y Santa Teresa de Ávila, podemos enorgullecernos de citar los muchos logros de Teresa, al mismo tiempo que nos esforzamos por seguir su ejemplo y nos sentimos cómodos sabiendo que Teresa, como nosotros, enfrentó muchas dudas y desafíos en el camino.
