FROM MONSIGNOR HARRINGTON'S DESK DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DE MONSEÑOR HARRINGTON

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ:
As you know, our two parishes, The Church of Saint Teresa of Avila and the Co-Cathedral of Saint Joseph will be merged effective November 1, 2018. Many of our neighboring churches have already merged. Saint Matthew's-St. Gregory-Our Lady of Charity are three churches but one parish and Holy Rosary-Our Lady of Victory-St. Peter Claver are three churches but one parish. The catalysts for these mergers is a decrease in the church attending population and the clergy shortage that is impacting the Church here in the United States.

At the outset let us acknowledge our long-term hope- that would be that both Saint Teresa and Saint Joseph will at sometime in the future be separate self-sustaining parishes. For that to happen, we will all have to strive to ensure that our churches will be vibrant centers of faith. That

our Eucharistic celebrations would give fitting tribute and honor to God, that our faith formation would impart deeper knowledge of the teachings of the Master, and that the community would sustain one another in the everyday living out of our relationship as adopted sons and daughters of God. The fruits of this cultivation will be manifest to all when we see that the vocations of Religious Life, Holy Matrimony and Holy Orders are fostered and so flourish.

The scriptures remind us that some are called to reap while others are called to sow. We are the ones called to sow at some point in the future others will reap the fruits of our labors. Before we sow we must take an honest look at our garden. Like people, we as church communities also have baggage that must be addressed. The accumulated possessions and experiences of our shared history can be a strength and a weakness.

I am excited to work with you all in listening to the Lord and finding the best ways to evangelize our community and grow as one family of faith.

FROM MONSIGNOR HARRINGTON'S DESK

Jesus grants us the great commission "to baptize all nations". Let us begin the work now together!

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en Cristo:
Como saben, nuestras dos parroquias, la Iglesia de Santa Teresa de Ávila y la Co-catedral de San José se fusionarán a partir del 1 de noviembre de 2018. un conocimiento más profundo de las enseñanzas del Maestro y que la comunidad se sostiene mutuamente en la vida cotidiana de nuestra relación como hijos e hijas adoptados de Dios. 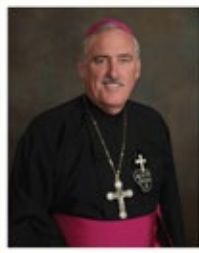

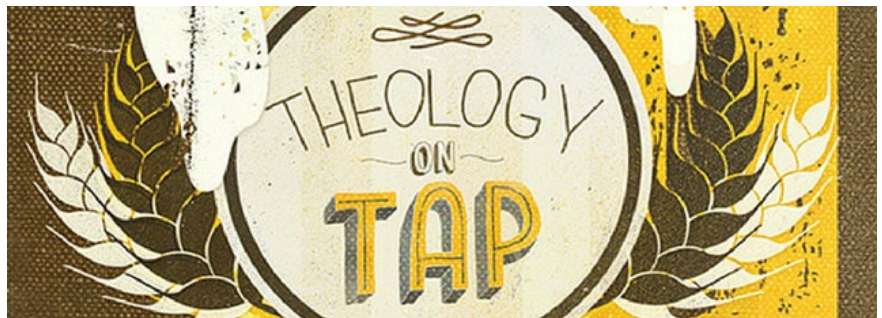
