## ALL SAINTS' DAY AND ALL SOULS' DAY DÍA DE LOS SANTOS Y EL DÍA DE TODAS LAS ALMAS



**T**his week when the broader culture dresses up as ghouls and goblins to celebrate Halloween, we Christians will celebrate all Saint's Day and All Soul's Day. Hallows is the Scottish Celtic word for saints and the wen describes the evening prior. Ironically, the broader cultured has demeaned and in some cases perverted this evening vigil of All Saint's. What is a Christian to do? We at Saint Teresa and Saint Joseph have sought to remind our young people of the importance of these feast days by asking our children to dress up as saints. These are our Christian heroes, men and women, who have in some cases died for their love of Christ and in other cases have made a great contribution to the living out of the life of faith. This year, my attention

is turned towards Archbishop Oscar Romero who was recently canonized. I am interested in learning more about him by reading his writings and studying his life. Moreover, it is a great blessing to discover more about the life of Bishop Francis Xavier Ford who was also a boy from our parish of Saint Joseph. Ford was one of the first to join the Maryknoll Missionary Fathers and journeyed to China as a young priest and received in return martyrdom at the hands of the communist revolutionaries. On all Soul's Day my attention always turns to my grandparents who shared with me the great gift of faith. I also pray that the Eternal Father will be merciful in judging my brother priests and religious, friends and parishioners

### BILINGUAL CONVOCATION OF LITURGICAL AND PASTORAL MINISTERS



On Saturday, October 13, at Immaculate Conception Center in Douglaston, Queens, there were several hundred participants at the event, including large groups from St. Teresa of Avila and St. Joe's. The Convocation had a packed agenda with something for everyone, including a presentation on the Eucharistic Prayer and workshops in both English and Spanish. This beautiful day ended with a moving communal bilingual Adoration of the Eucharist.
