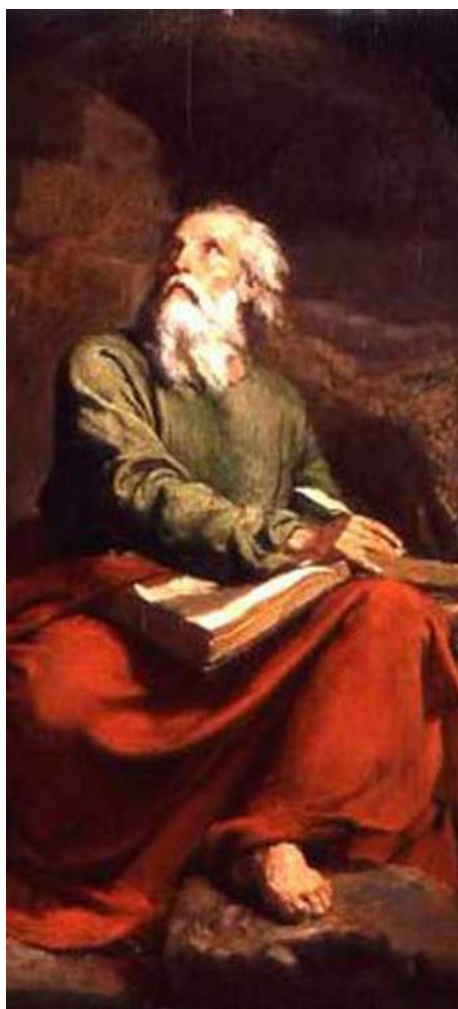

When a kid has a box, it can be anything, right? A house, a castle, a cave. So it's already more flexible than most of today's fancy toys ... a box abides by the simple "good toy" principle, which is that it gives all the make-believe power to the kid. A good toy, they say, is 10 percent toy, and 90 percent child. The toy gets the play started, but it's his own ideas, his own creativity, his unique personality, that makes his games wonderful. The Good Toy Principle is helping me cut through all of that noise, and point me towards the things I know my kids will play with for more than a week.

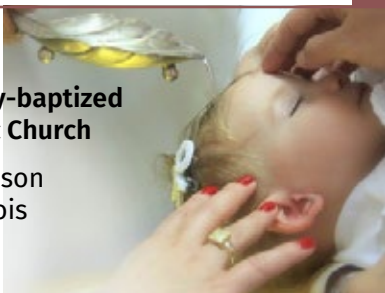

OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE FEAST

On December 12th, in Mexico, the United States and across the Americas, we honor Our Lady of Guadalupe. On December 9, 1531, Juan Diego, an Indian convert to the faith, was walking to a nearby village so that he could attend Mass. On his way, a woman appeared to him amidst the sound of celestial music. She announced to him: "I am your merciful Mother, to you and to all mankind who love me and trust in me and invoke my help." The Feast of Our Lady, therefore, ought not simply be seen as a cultural, historical or miraculous phenomena. Rather, it must be seen as a glorious invitation from the Queen of Heaven to accept her as our mother.

Dearest Mother, Virgin of Guadalupe, I consecrate myself to your motherly care. I thank you for your perfect concern, help and mercy. Please intercede for me as I place my trust in you. Take me to Your Son Jesus that I may love Him with your beautiful heart. Mother Mary, pray for us. St. Juan Diego, pray for us. Jesus, I trust in You.

FIESTA DE NUESTRA SEÑORA DE GUADALUPE

El 12 de diciembre, en México, Estados Unidos y en todo el continente americano, honramos a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. El 9 de diciembre de 1531, Juan Diego, un indio convertido a la fe, caminaba hacia un pueblo cercano para poder asistir a la misa. En el camino, una mujer se le apareció en medio del sonido de la música celestial. Ella le anunció: "Soy tu Madre misericordiosa, para ti y para toda la humanidad que me ama y confía en mí e invoca mi ayuda". La Fiesta de Nuestra Señora, por lo tanto, no debe ser vista simplemente como un fenómeno cultural, histórico o milagroso. Más bien, debe verse como una invitación gloriosa de la Reina del Cielo para aceptarla como nuestra madre.

Querida madre, Virgen de Guadalupe, me consagro a tu cuidado maternal. Te agradezco tu perfecta preocupación, ayuda y misericordia. Por favor intercede por mí mientras yo confío en ti. Llévame a tu Hijo Jesús para que pueda amarlo con tu hermoso corazón. Madre María, ruega por nosotros. San Juan Diego, ruega por nosotros. Jesús, en ti confío.

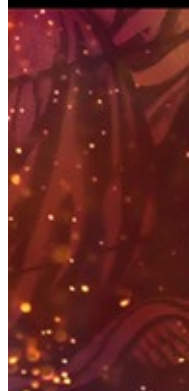
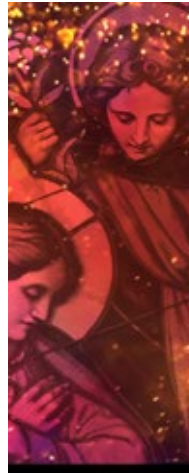
