### LOOKING AT MARRIAGE DURING LENT, PART 2

Our Lenten journey should begin in prayer and move into silence. The process of growing is often about learning how to become less selfish. That's easy to do on our good days. But on our bad days, we might look at our spouse and grumble: "Why is it always ME who has to do the giving? We are called to love in marriage in the same way Jesus loves us – without limits. And so sometimes we have to try love our spouse who is crabby and barking. It's about loving someone who might not be very loveable right now. ## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT, CYCLE C SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA, CICLO C

### PILGRIMAGE TO HOLY LAND

Last week 24 pilgrims from St. Joseph's-St. Teresa's parish visited the Holy Land, along with another 40 from across the Brooklyn Diocese. The group was led by Auxiliary Bishop Neil Tiedemann, and Msgr. Harrington served as chaplain. The pilgrims followed Jesus' steps, visiting many of the sites where Jesus conducted his ministry, including Cana, Capernaum, Mt. Tabor, and Jericho. They also visited Bethlehem to see the cave where He was born, and Nazareth where He grew up. The highlight of the trip was a visit to Jerusalem, where they carried a cross along the Via Dolorosa, experiencing the stations of the cross on the same path that Jesus walked 2000 years ago. The pilgrims also celebrated mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, which contains the tomb where Jesus was laid to rest and from which He rose from the dead. Our pilgrims found fellowship and a deeper faith in an experience they will never forget.

### PEREGRINACIÓN A TIERRA SANTA

La semana pasada 24 peregrinos de la parroquia de St. Joseph's y Sta. Teresa visitaron la Tierra Santa, junto con 40 peregrinos de toda la Diócesis de Brooklyn. El grupo fue dirigido por el obispo auxiliar Neil Tiedemann, y Mons. Harrington quien sirvió como capellán. Los peregrinos siguieron los pasos de Jesús, visitando muchos de los sitios donde Jesús llevó a cabo su ministerio, incluyendo Cana, Capernaum, Mt. Tabor, y Jericó. También visitaron Belén para ver la cueva donde nació Jesús, y Nazaret, donde fue criado. El punto culminante del viaje fue una visita a Jerusalén, donde llevaron una cruz a lo largo de la Vía Dolorosa, experimentando la Viacrucis en el mismo lugar donde Jesús caminó hace 2000 años. Los peregrinos también celebraron una misa en la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro, que contiene la tumba donde Jesús fue enterrado y de la cual se levantó de entre los muertos. Nuestros peregrinos encontraron compañerismo y una fe más profunda en una experiencia que nunca olvidarán.

**THE PRIMACY OF THE INTERIOR LIFE**

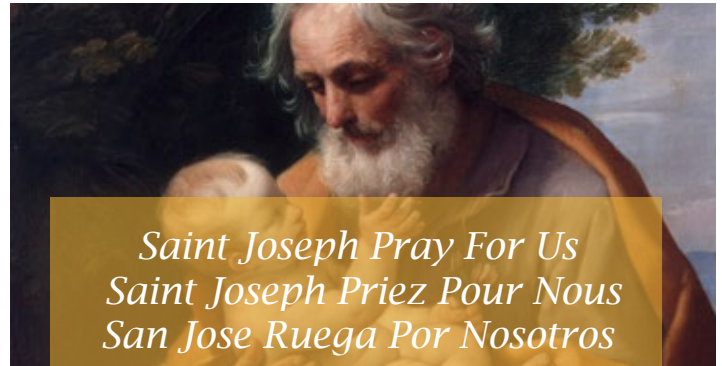
