Today we celebrate Corpus Christi Sunday. We Catholics believe that the Eucharist is the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord Jesus Christ. As we know from John chapter 6, this powerful mystery was a cause of so much scandal that those fed with the Bread from heaven themselves turned away from Him. In our own age, we may articulate a belief in the Eucharistic presence but our lack of faith is often apparent. The casual way we approach the sacred mysteries by failing to prepare for the encounter

with the living God is a challenge for priests and people. Have we spent time in prayer? Have we gone to confession? Are we appropriately attired? After our reception of Communion do we make an appropriate thanksgiving? Do we recognize that we ourselves become the living Tabernacle of the Lord?

This year let us be attentive to who we adore and unashamedly proclaim our love for Him, as we walk the streets of our city.

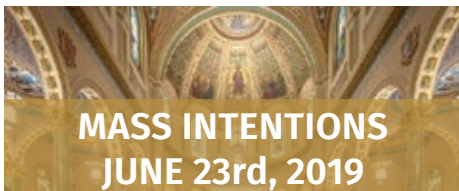

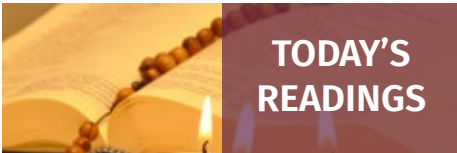

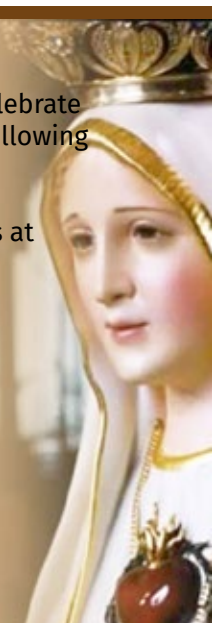
