

THE CO-CATHEDRAL OF SAINT JOSEPH

FROM MONSIGNOR HARRINGTON'S DESK DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DE MONSEÑOR HARRINGTON DU BUREAU DE MGR HARRINGTON

Today's Gospel sounds puzzling to contemporary readers, but can be made less so by considering the economic system which stands behind the parable. A steward is dismissed because he is squandering his master's property. He is called dishonest because he is not serving the interests of the rich man. In an attempt to ensure favor for himself among the rich man's debtors, he brokers repayment of the rich man's loans by foregoing the interest and fees that had been levied to line the steward's pockets. The steward puts aside his greed and takes the longer perspective in order to enhance his security, which is commended by the rich man.

The passage exhorts the listener to be prudent about the use of wealth. Like the steward in the parable, those who would follow Jesus must put transitory affairs in proper perspective. Christians should handle the affairs of temporal life with an eye toward eternal life. Jesus tells his listeners that no one can serve two masters simultaneously. God must be put ahead of money.

El Evangelio de hoy suena desconcertante para los lectores contemporáneos, pero se puede ser menos considerar el sistema económico que está detrás de la parábola. Un mayordomo es despedido porque en el conerto de su amo. Lo llaman deshonesto porque no está sirviendo a los intereses del hombre rico, su empleador. En un intento de asegurar el favor entre los deudores del hombre rico, el mayordomo negocia el pago de los préstamos del hombre rico al

renunciar a los intereses y honorarios que se habían cobrado para forjar los bolsillos del mayordomo. El mayordomo deja de lado su codicia y toma la perspectiva más larga para mejorar su seguridad, la cual es elogiada por el hombre rico.

El pasaje exhorta al oyente a ser prudente sobre el uso de la riqueza. Al igual que el mayordomo de la parábola, los que han de seguir a Jesús deben poner los asuntos transitorios en una perspectiva adecuada. Los cristianos deben manejar los asuntos de la vida temporal con la vista puesta en la vida eterna. Jesús le dice a sus oyentes que nadie puede servir a dos amos simultáneamente. Dios debe estar por delante del dinero.

PROCESSION FOR MOTHER CABRINI

The City of New York recently held a competition with the goal of recognizing notable New York women who contributed to the development of the city. Although St. Frances X. Cabrini received the most votes in the competition, she was denied the recognition of a public statue in her honor. Bishop Nicholas DiMarzio will lead a procession in honor of St. Frances X. Cabrini through the streets she walked on in Brooklyn. The procession begins Sunday, October 6th at 3 pm at Mother Cabrini Park (41 President Street, Brooklyn, NY 11231) and leads to a 4 pm Mass at Sacred Hearts - St. Stephen Church (125 Summit Street, Brooklyn, NY 11231).

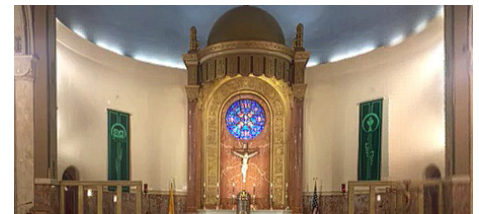
