FROM MONSIGNOR HARRINGTON'S DESK DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DE MONSEÑOR HARRINGTON DU BUREAU DE MGR HARRINGTON

Jesus speaks in parables, emphasizing that although there is a right way to be a disciple and enter into the kingdom of his Father, it is a difficult path to follow. Many, even some of the guests at the table, reject the invitation. So Jesus turns to the crowds and speaks to them of discipleship. Jesus explains that, when it comes to making a choice for the Kingdom of God, nothing can get in the way. When Jesus describes "hating" one's father and mother, he is not talking about feelings. Rather, he is emphasizing very strongly that choosing to be a disciple means that everything else — family, money, your own life — must come second.

Jesús habla en parábolas, enfatizando que aunque hay una manera correcta de ser discípulo y entrar en el reino de su Padre, es un camino difícil de seguir. Muchos, incluso algunos de los invitados a la mesa, rechazan la invitación. Así que Jesús se vuelve hacia las multitudes y les habla de el discípulo. Jesús explica que, cuando se trata de tomar una decisión

para el Reino de Dios, nada puede entrar en el camino. Cuando Jesús describe "odiar" al padre y a la madre, no está hablando de sentimientos. Más bien, está enfatizando muy fuertemente que elegir ser discípulo significa que todo lo demás — familia, dinero, tu propia vida— debe ser segundo.

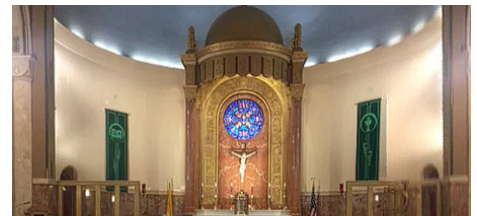
